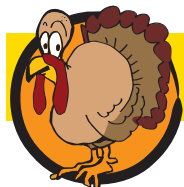

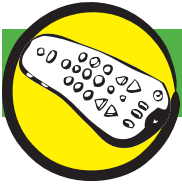


## garden coordinator
